Orlando International Airport Design Concept

This airport was developed as a total environmentally responsive complex that has high passenger convenience features, low maintenance and operational costs, accommodates a high growth rate and reflects the unique character of the Central Florida environment.

The Orlando Experience® is a design theme conveyed throughout the airport with unique architecture, aesthetics and convenience amenities.



Project: Permanent Specialty Flooring

- In the renovation of the North Terminal Ticket Lobbies, it is suggested that consideration be given to a permanent public art project that would be
 - Wayfinding element
 - Meeting point
 - Add texture to the project by adding another dimension in a neutral pallet
 - Unique greeting that reflects elements of Central Florida environment

Location

The specialty flooring or location area is identified as a welcome mat and will be located in four different areas. The works must reflect the criteria set by the authority.

- **Location one:** West end between quad A1 and A2
- **Location two:** East end between quad A3 and A4
- **Location three:** West in between quad B2 and B3
- **Location four:** East in between quad B3 and B4

Selection Process

Recommended process:

- Create a criteria for art concept
- Submittal of Statement of Qualifications (SOQ) following the established criteria (preference for work experience in Terrazzo medium)
- Evaluation of concept by City of Orlando/Orange County Public Art Boards
- Board Approval

Designs will be evaluated on artistic excellence as evidenced by submitted materials, professional experience, compatibility with the architectural design and the permanent specialty flooring criteria outlined in the SOQ.

Installation

- The GOAA contractor for the ticket counter project will install the permanent terrazzo flooring in conjunction with the artist's oversight of the concept approved.
- The successful artist will need to work closely with the Airport and its representatives to ensure the new flooring is coordinated with the building including the technical requirements. The material will be of Epoxy Terrazzo thin set specifications.



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
