



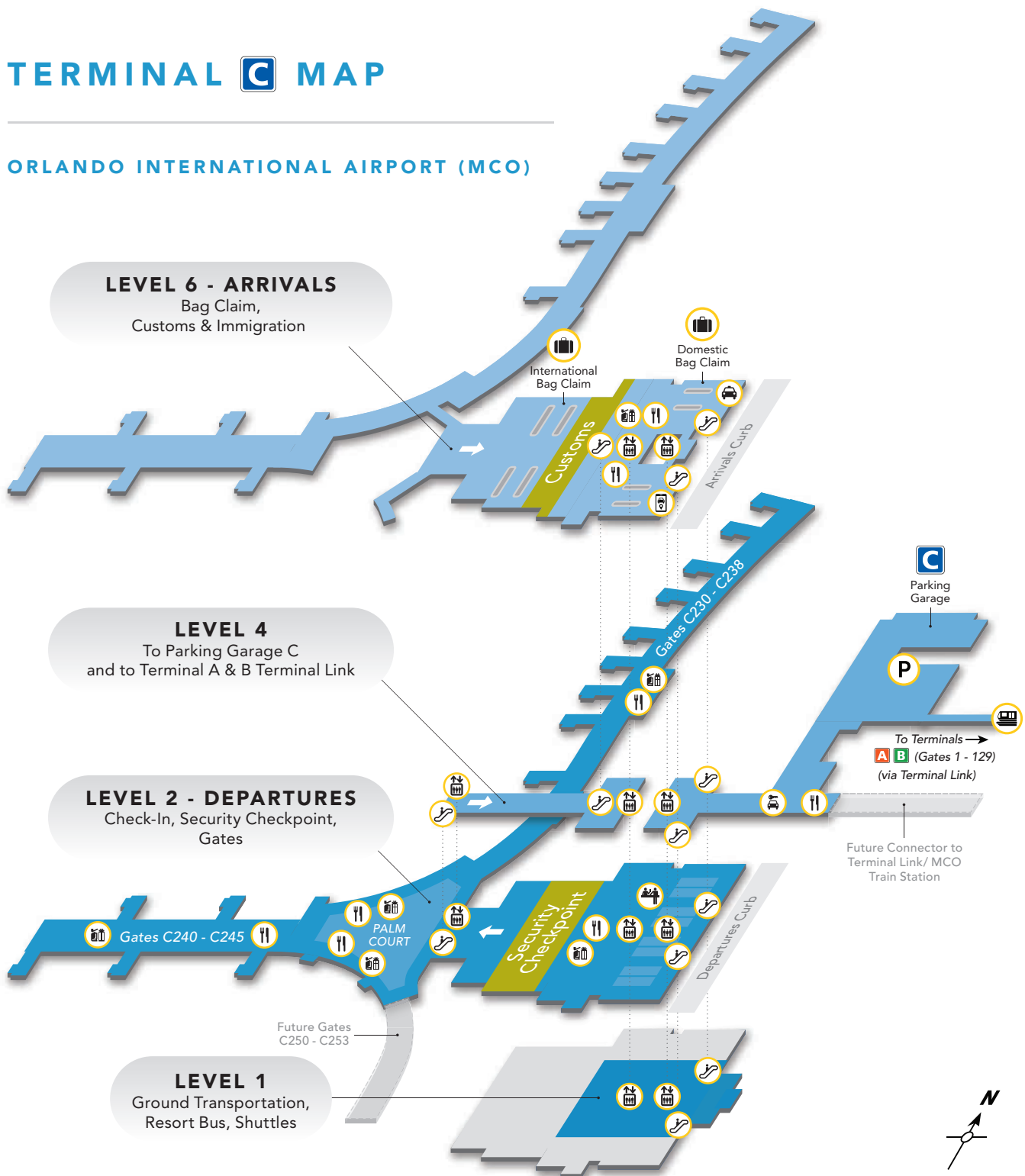

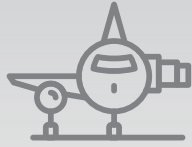

TERMINAL C TECHNOLOGY FEATURES

- 100% facial recognition for international arrival and departures
- TSA security screening lanes featuring an automated bin return system
- A new “Bags First” method for arriving international travelers. Passengers retrieve their “Bags First” then proceed to U.S. Customs and Immigration
- Radio Frequency Identification Technology (RFID) Tote Baggage Handling System for efficient tracking
- Simultaneous international and domestic gate arrival operations
- Adjacent to MCO’s train station with high-speed inter-city rail service commencing in 2023
- With sustainability in mind, many design elements for the Terminal C target LEED@v4 certification, including areas such as energy efficiency, indoor air quality and resiliency

The “Moment Vault” will engage visitors with imaginative & unique displays. This series of digital interactive multimedia experiences are presented in 15K imagery, and places visitors directly in immersive and creative scenes, adding another joyful element to the travelers’ journey.
