Pursuant to the policies and procedures of the Greater Orlando Aviation Authority (the "Authority"), notice is hereby given that Statement of Qualifications (SOQs) are invited from firms and individuals ("Proposers") to render professional consulting services (the "Services") to the Authority for **W-00365 GOAA Lock & Key System Upgrade Evaluation** ("Project") at the Orlando International Airport (the "Airport").

Summary Description of the Project: This project is to provide professional services in support of identifying and recommending a key and lock system for existing and future doors and access points at the Airport.

The professional services for the Project include, but are not limited to, evaluation and documentation of the current key and lock enterprise system; research and recommendations for the most effective solution for an campus wide lock and key system; provide equipment specifications for the purchase and installation of a new high security key and lock system capable of being retrofitted into the existing door and lock hardware at the Airport, and all other related services including coordination with the Authority, its Consultants, tenants, and security agencies having jurisdiction at the Airport.

The Services may also include, but are not limited to, studies and preparation of reports involving scope definition and validation of projects, evaluation and documentation of existing conditions; cost estimating and scheduling; bid and award services; implementation administration; development of a Master Key Inventory system support, technical support; review of documents prepared by others; verification of as-built conditions including field verification of installed equipment; installation management support; other related professional services which may be required where the Authority elects not to solicit SOQs by means of public advertisement; and all other related services including coordination with the Authority, its Consultants, the City of Orlando and all agencies having jurisdiction over the Project.

A Pre-Submittal Conference will be held **at 2:00 p.m., Tuesday, April 11, 2017, in the Maintenance Shops Classroom, Greater Orlando Aviation Authority, Orlando International Airport, 8648 Casa Verde Road, Orlando, FL 32827.** The Project Scope, the Submission Requirements, the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Program, the Minority and Women Business Enterprise (MWBE) Participation Program, the Service Disabled Veteran Owned Business Enterprise (SDVOBE) Program, and Local Developing Business (LDB) Participation Program for the SOQs and questions regarding the Project will be reviewed at the Pre-Submittal Conference.

The selected Proposer will be prohibited from submitting a bid/proposal on the contract to furnish and install the product solution.
